Refrain: “**We cannot live . . .**”
 3. Song of Hope:
Verse 1: “. . . **if you believe in me,
even though you die, you will live.**”
 4. We Thank You, Father:
Refrain: “. . . **and for the gift of life with each other . . .**”
 8. Love Is Here:
Verse 3: “**Friends (held for 3 beats) all we’re bound to be . . .**”
 10. The Prophet’s Cry:
“. . . **that all who live may see the salvation of God,
that all who live . . .**”
 12. Peace:
Verse 1: “. . . **to be the hope for all who live.**”
Verse 3: “**By this love which you should have,
all (held for 2 beats) will know you are my friends.**”

2. **Unless We are Born** (Unless A Man):
Refrain: “**Unless (held for 2 beats) we are . . . , we cannot see . . .**”
Verse 1: “**Unless we are born . . . , we cannot enter . . .**”
3. The Dove Song:
“. . . **fatigue which ev’ryone will know until the end.**”
“. . . **and heal the strife we nurture for ourselves.**”
“. . . **all is calm, the dove is gone upon its way . . .**”

Wherever You Go *(continued)*

5. Yahweh:

Refrain: “Yahweh*, the God of our salvation:
we trust in You and have no fear.
We sing of the joy which Your love gives to us,
and we draw deeply from the springs of Your
great kindness.”

**The syllable -weh is sung on a half note.*

Verse 2: “Be with us, God, as we...”

Verse 3: “give us rest, O God...”

6. Walk in the Shoes:

“Walk in the shoes of another for a mile,
. . . who is greater in the kingdom where all are free.
Carry on your shoulder each other’s weakness and troubles . . .”

9. All Those Who Love Me (If Anyone Loves Me):

“All those who (3 equal beats) love me, will keep my word,
and my father will love them, and we shall come to them
and make our home with them.”

"Into the desert of our lives, bringing truth and freedom,
God comes to us." (*Occurs 3 times*)

19. **Happy the Just Ones** (*Happy Man*):

Refrain: "O happy, O happy are the just ones,
who are sincere in their love of God."

Verse 1: "Happy indeed are (2 beats) those
who follow not the counsel of the wicked,
but whose delight is the law of (2 beats) God
and who ponder that law day and night."
